The EliteMicro automated CD/DVD duplication system with new Autograph6 printer from Disc Makers is an ideal entry-level system for churches of any size. Starting at just \$2,390, the standalone unit sets up out of the box and, according to Disc Makers reps, has the smallest footprint in the industry, saving valuable desktop space.

Available in both CD-R and DVD formats, the 48x EliteMicro duplicates at least 20 CD-Rs or two DVD-Rs per hour. And although the EliteMicro is small, its input and output bins can hold up to 50 discs for greater unattended duplication capacity. The EliteMicro can easily be connected to any PC (Windows XP or 2000 required) via a Firewire card and cable. It also includes basic networking functionality, so it can be controlled using any computer or network.

The Autograph6 is fully compatible with the Disc Makers' ElitePro Series of CD-R/DVD-R automated duplication systems. It is supported by Windows 98, 2000, ME and XP, and it offers high throughput at up to 20 discs per hour in high-quality mode. It can print up to 4800 x 1200 dpi. The Autograph6 also comes with easy-to-use Discus labeling software and an adaptor kit for printing on CardDiscs.
